HOW TO MAKE A SIMPLE COLOR SCAVENGER HUNT

DIRECTIONS FOR THIS SCAVENGER HUNT

1. Write “Color Scavenger Hunt” at the top of your white paper lunch bag.
2. Choose the colors you want the children to hunt for and use your colored markers to scribble small squares onto the front of the bag of each color.



3. Pass out the bags and let them have fun finding all of the colors on the bag. When they find an item that matches one of the colors, place it in the bag. When everyone is finished, sit in a circle and have a fun time having a show and tell about all of the items everyone found.
